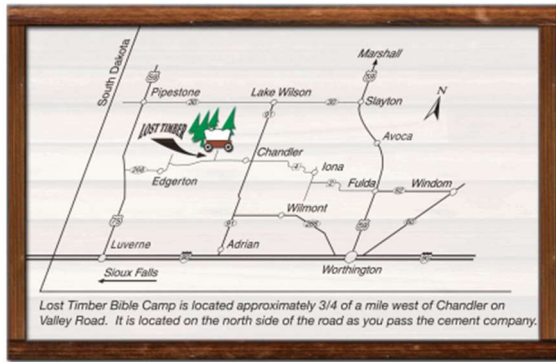


## Location and Directions

Cancellations must be made at least 10 days before your child's scheduled camp to receive a refund. If you cancel less than 10 days before your child's camp, refunds will only be given for medical reasons or family emergencies. **All refunds are subject to a \$25 administration fee.**

2. Camp ends at 2 p.m. on the last day of each group.
3. LASER TAG for all groups. This is an optional activity one afternoon each week. It costs \$10.

## What to bring to camp

- Bible, Notebook, Pen/Pencil, Flashlight, Camera.
- Bedding: Pillow, Sleeping Bag or Sheets/Blankets.
