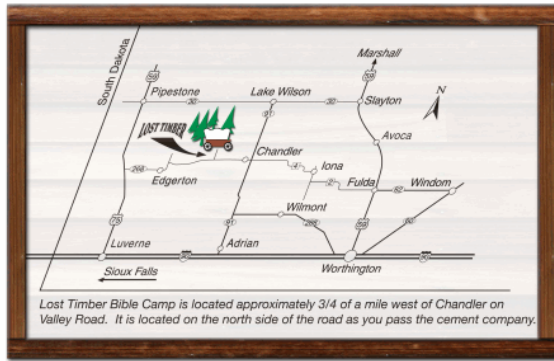


## Location and Directions



Turn onto County Road 4 into Chandler from the intersection with County Road 4 and Highway 91. Drive through town and another 1.5 miles west of town. ### Refund policy

Cancellations must be made at least 10 days before your child's scheduled camp to receive a refund. If you cancel less than 10 days before your child's camp, refunds will only be given for medical reasons or family emergencies. **All refunds are subject to a \$25 administration fee.**

### Things you need to know

1. Camp registration is from 10-11 a.m. on the 1<sup>st</sup> morning for each group.
2. Camp ends at 2 p.m. on the last day of each group.
3. TEEN AND INTERMEDIATE CAMP..... paintball. This is an optional activity one afternoon each week. It costs \$30. **This must be paid for when registration is sent in.**

### What to bring to camp
